- 1 Start a spending audit within the first 90 days**
A department-by-department review of City spending.
- 2 New programs prove their value**
Every new program has to show it's worth it before it gets funded.
- 3 Grow revenue, not your tax bill**
Economic development, and Burlington's fair share of provincial and federal funding.
